The template for the Detecting the Atmospheric Response to the Changing Face of the Earth: A Focus on Human-Caused Regional Climate Forcings, Land-Cover/Land-Use Change, and Data Monitoring Workshop, August 2007 is quite simple. Please submit a one-page abstract **in PDF format (using Acrobat or other software that is compatible with Acrobat 4.0)** that follows the guidelines specified herein. Abstracts should be placed on an 8.5 by 11-inch page with 1-inch margin from all sides.

All text should utilize the Helvetica font. If this font family is not available, an alternative sans-serif font should be used. Center the title (bold type, 14-point font) at the top of the page followed by a single space and then authors and affiliations (still centered) in size 12-font (as demonstrated above). Underline presenting author. Please include complete mailing address and email information for all authors.

Following the affiliation information, insert a blank line. Abstract content should use left and right-justified (first line indented 0.5 inches) paragraph style, single or 1.5- line spacing, using Helvetica 12-point font.

Images and figures (with suitable legends and labels) are allowed to the extent of fitting comfortably on the single page abstract. Images and figures will be reproduced in hardcopy in black and white as they appear in the PDF file. Authors are encouraged to check legibility of all text and figures as they appear in the PDF file to insure the quality of the abstract is suitable for distribution.

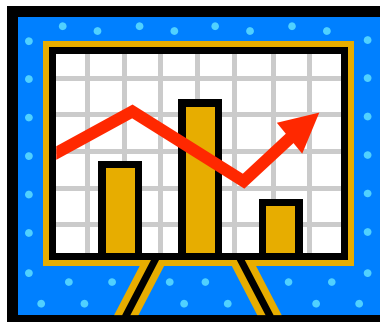


Figure 1: Funds available for research: 2001-2010
